Genesis 41

¹⁴ So Pharaoh sent for Joseph, and he was quickly brought from the dungeon. When he had shaved and changed his clothes, he came before Pharaoh. ¹⁵ Pharaoh said to Joseph, "I had a dream, and no one can interpret it. But I have heard it said of you that when you hear a dream you can interpret it."

Joseph refuses to buckle under the pressure of the moment

¹⁶ "I cannot do it," Joseph replied to Pharaoh, "but God will give Pharaoh the answer he desires."

Joseph has a new boldness

²⁵ Then Joseph said to Pharaoh, "The dreams of Pharaoh are one and the same. God has revealed to Pharaoh what he is about to do.

Joseph has a new discernment

³⁷ The plan seemed good to Pharaoh and to all his officials. ³⁸ So Pharaoh asked them, "Can we find anyone like this man, one in whom is the spirit of God?"

Joseph has a new bent

³⁹ Then Pharaoh said to Joseph, "Since God has made all this known to you, there is no one so discerning and wise as you. ⁴⁰ You shall be in charge of my palace, and all my people are to submit to your orders. Only with respect to the throne will I be greater than you."

Joseph has a new platform

Important Truths

All of the character bending that Joseph endured made perfect sense in his moment before Pharaoh.

God uses bent people to bring about his divine purpose.

- 1) Describe a defining moment of your life (a discovery, an experience, a medical diagnosis, the birth of a child, etc.) that you believe changed the trajectory of your whole existence.
- 2) Is it easier for you to be faithful to God in good or tough times?
- 3) Have you ever encountered a powerful person? Did their power or stature cause you to change how you presented yourself? Why?
- 4) Joseph is suddenly prosperous. Often, prosperity challenges our faith in God. How has prosperity affected your ability to trust God? (For perspective, living in the U.S. puts you in the top 10% of wealthiest people in the world.)
- 5) How is God bending you this week?
- 6) How can we pray for you right now?
