A Biblical Strategy for Giving Yourself Away (Ephesians 5:1-2)

¹Be imitators of God, therefore, as dearly loved children...

Imitators = *mimetes;* one who is like another; mimic; mime **Application:** We are to imitate the character and

life of Jesus

^{2a} ...and live a life of love, just as Christ loved us...

What does it mean to live a life of love?

⁴Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. ⁵It is not rude, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. ⁶Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. ⁷It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres.

The pure expression of God's love for us:

This is love; not that we loved God but that He loved us and send His Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins. – 1 John 4:10
