# My Simple Definition of Prayer

Prayer is both talking to and listening to God.

### Luke 22:39-46

<sup>39</sup> Jesus went out as usual to the Mount of Olives, and his disciples followed him. <sup>40</sup> On reaching the place, he said to them, "Pray that you will not fall into temptation." <sup>41</sup> He withdrew about a stone's throw beyond them, knelt down and prayed, <sup>42</sup> "Father, if you are willing, take this cup from me; yet not my will, but yours be done." <sup>43</sup> An angel from heaven appeared to him and strengthened him. <sup>44</sup> And being in anguish, he prayed more earnestly, and his sweat was like drops of blood falling to the ground.

<sup>45</sup> When he rose from prayer and went back to the disciples, he found them asleep, exhausted from sorrow. <sup>46</sup> "Why are you sleeping?" he asked them. "Get up and pray so that you will not fall into temptation."

A <u>retreat</u>	Jesus went out
A pattern	as usual
A location	to the Mount of Olives
A <u>posture</u>	knelt down and prayed
A <u>connection</u>	Father
A <u>request</u>	if you are willing
A moment of <u>honesty</u>	take this cup from me
A <u>submission</u>	yet not my will, but yours be done
A heavenly <u>strength</u>	an angel appearedand strengthened him
A response to <u>pain</u>	being in anguish, he prayed more earnestly
A <u>re-entry</u>	he rose from prayer and went back
