
This growth guide is designed to be used together as a Christ-centered community. As you are doing that week's exercise, so will your small group and your fellow body that gathers together on Sundays.

The Order of activities to fully maximize your experience:

- 2. Attend our Sunday **GATHERING** and listen to the message related to the content you just completed in the guide the week before.
- 3. Connect with your small **GROUP** in how to live out what you've learned and experienced through our Doing Life Together Discussion (available in our Sunday programs in person or at ctk.church/NorthBay/Genesis).



INTRODUCTION TO GENESIS

TITLE/AUTHOR

Genesis is called the Book of Beginnings or Book of Origins. The ancient Hebrews called the book Bereshith, meaning "In the beginning," which are the first words of the text. It is also sometimes referred to as the "First Book of Moses."

PURPOSE

The Book of Genesis chornicles the creation of the universe, the world, humankind, and all other forms of life. As the Book of Beginnings, it reveals the ageless plan within God's heart to have a people of His very own, set apart and made holy to worship Him, and further foreshadows His redemptive plan through Jesus to "the saving of many lives" (Genesis 50:21).

THEMES

The Book of Genesis sets the stage for the rest of Scripture. Without the foundation of Genesis, the reaminder of the Bible would fail to make sense.

The main theme of Genesis is beginnings. The book recounts the origins of the Heavens and Earth, of all created things, of the human family, of God's covenant relationship with humans, of sin, of redemption, of nations, of languages, and of God's chosen people of Israel.

Genesis teaches us about the problem of sin and God's plan of salvation. It reveals the character of God and his relentless pursuit to restore the broken fellowship between human beings and himself.

The stories in Genesis reveal the nature of God as Creator and Redeemer, the value of human life (created in God's image and for His purpose), the terrible consequences of disobedience and sin (separating man from God), and the wonderful promise of salvation and forgiveness through the coming Messiah.

THE WEEKS

Weekly Growth Guide Instructions

BIBLE READING

Read the assigned chapters in Genesis for the week.

PLEASE NOTE: Some weeks have more chapters than others to read, so plan accordingly.

REFLECTION AND JOURNALING

After reading, reflect and engage your head, heart, and hands.


- 1. HEAD What did the Bible text say? Give a summary of what you read and any observations you found interesting enough to jot down.
- 2. HEART What does it mean to me? What personal thoughts did you have? How does it make you feel like God may have spoken to or challenged you?
- 3. HANDS What do I do with it now?
 Do you feel convicted after reading and reflecting? What specific action step(s) do you feel led to accomplish this week? Be prepared to share with your small group what you got out of your personal growth time.


GROUP TIME
