Ephesians 2:19

Consequently, you are no longer foreigners and strangers, but fellow citizens with God's people and also members of his household... (NIV)

So now you Gentiles are no longer strangers and foreigners. You are citizens along with all of God's holy people. You are members of God's family. (NLT)

So then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God... (ESV)

Now you are no longer strangers to God and foreigners to heaven, but you are members of God's very own family, citizens of God's country, and you belong in God's household with every other Christian. (TLB)

Truths from Ephesians 2:19

1. There was a time when we were all outsiders, but that changed
"...you are no longer foreigners and strangers..."
2. When we become followers of Jesus, we join God's kingdom
"You are citizens..."

"...members of the household of God..."

Movement: Starting more and more churches
