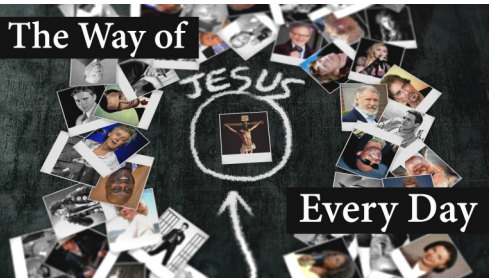

Study & Discussion for Your Next Small Group

Theme: Eyewitnesses

Share Together: When has there been a time you witnessed an accident or situation? What were the results?

Reflect Together: What impacted you the most from Sunday's message, and how were you able to apply this week's spiritual practice by forming as a D-Group? Discuss how your group will participate and your hope for this season of discipleship together.

Read Together: Luke 1:1-4 (NIV)

Discuss Together:

- What do you think was Luke's rationale for such an opening in the gospel he writes?
- What does "many have undertaken to draw up an account" imply?
- As far as we know, Luke never met Jesus when He was on the earth so why did he write the gospel of Luke?
- Why were these eyewitnesses important? Read John 1:14 and 2 Peter 1:16 for help.
- How are we "eyewitnesses" of Jesus today? How can we be more effective in being eyewitnesses?
- Who was Theophilus and what was his role based on what you heard on Sunday and what you may already know of him? Read Acts 1:1 how does this person tie Luke's writings together?
- What does Luke mean by "so you may know the certainty?" What is this certainty?
How does the gospel of Jesus bring certainty to your life?
- How can you use prayer for your doubts about it?

Pray Together: Share updates of God answering prayer and requests to pray for.
