Joshua 23: 6-13

Joshua 23: 14-15

- How do these verses encourage your own faith?
- What's a favorite promise of God in the scriptures that is special to you, why?

Joshua 24: 14-15

- How do the words of Joshua in these verses impact you right now and looking ahead?
- Where do you feel the most tension at times in following the leading of Christ:
  - 1. COMMITTING to your sense of his leading?
  - 2. SUBMITTING to taking action on it?
  - 3. LIVING it out in an ongoing manner?
