- 1. Coalition of immorality (vs.2)
- 2. <u>Blasphemy</u> (vs. 3)
- 3. The mirage of <u>beauty</u> (vs. 4)
- 4. Murder of God's people (vs. 6)
- 5. Sensual, subtle, and surprising (vs. 8)

Hope in the Face of Evil

They will wage war against the Lamb, but the Lamb will triumph over them because he is Lord of lords and King of kings—and with him will be his called, chosen and faithful followers." (vs. 14)

- 6. Composed of humanity that rejects God (vs. 15)
- 7. Turn on each other because there is no <u>conscience</u> (vs. 16)

The name written on her forehead was a mystery:

BABYLON THE GREAT THE MOTHER OF PROSTITUTES AND OF THE ABOMINATIONS OF THE EARTH

The wrong question to ask:

Who is Mystery Babylon?

The subtle marks of a Babylon/Rome mindset:

- 1. <u>Compromise</u> is the norm
- 2. Excess is supreme
- 3. Money and power are the ultimate goal
- 4. Ungodly partnerships lead to ruin

Practical wisdom for dealing with today's system:

- 1. <u>People</u> are more important than products
- 2. Pride will kill programs, plans and successes
- 3. Profit will never justify compromise
- 4. Godly decisions will keep you from mourning ungodly results

Love of the world pushes out love for God.

Love for God pushes out love of the world.

God's call in the face of compromise:

Then I heard another voice from heaven say: "'Come out of her, my people,' so that you will not share in her sins, so that you will not receive any of her plagues..." – Revelation 18:4
