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Small Group Conversation Guide

Transformation / 1 Corinthians 5:14-21

Warm-up: Share about a time when someone acted on your behalf and helped you in a moment of need. What happened and what was your response (relief, joy, etc)?

Read: 1 Corinthians 5:14-21

In this passage, Paul shows us how we've been transformed in Jesus. Jesus died for all of our sake. In Him we are a new creation and have been reconciled or reconnected to God.

1. After reading this passage, are there any words or phrases that stick out to you about

the work of Jesus? Why does it strike you personally?

- 2. What does it mean to be a new creation or new creature in Christ?
- 3. How does dying to self relate to becoming a new creation?
- 4. What does it mean to be reconciled to someone? How are we reconciled to God?
- 5. Paul says we are entrusted with the message of reconciliation as his ambassadors. How does this help define our purpose as His disciples?
- 6. What does it require of someone to be reconciled to God?
- 7. What other questions do you have of this passage? Does it challenge or comfort you?

Prayer: How can we pray for each other this week?

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
