# The Context of Luke 6

- 1) Do the work of rest and restoration on the Sabbath (verses 1-11)
- 2) Do this together (verses 12-16)
- 3) Do keep the right perspective: now versus eternity; blessing versus woe (verses 20-26)
- 4) Do the right work with your enemies (vs. 27-37)

# And then comes this...

Give, and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together and running over, will be poured into your lap. For with the measure you use, it will be measured to you." - Luke 6:38

### The wrong interpretation:

Giving is my ticket to prosperity

# The right interpretation:

I can't <u>out-give</u> God

Jesus promises a return on pure generosity

Jesus is the ultimate standard for generosity

The standard of never - I can't afford to

The standard of convenience – I will when it works for me

The standard of consistency – I will purpose in my heart

The standard of sacrifice — I will choose the joy of sharing the blessing I have in Jesus

## The Giving Style of Jesus

Grace and peace to you from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ, *who gave himself for our sins to rescue us* from the present evil age, according to the will of our God and Father, to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen. - Galatians 1:3-5 (*emphasis added*)

#### Jesus gave sacrificially

Jesus gave <u>completely</u>

Jesus gave <u>ultimately</u>
