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Text: John 21:1-17

That night they caught nothing. John 21:3

Some of the reasons we walk away from doing life God's way:

- <u>Disappointment</u> with God or ourselves
- The weariness of <u>religion</u>
- Being deceived into thinking there's a better way

Whenever you try to live life your way rather than God's way, you end up with <u>nothing</u>.

Early in the morning, Jesus stood on the shore. John 21:4

God raised him from the dead, freeing him from the agony of death, because it was impossible for death to keep its hold on him. Acts 2:24

When you see Jesus as a nothing more than a <u>legend</u>, it doesn't change anything but when see Jesus as the <u>risen Savior</u> it changes everything.

• You're given a brand new start.

We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life. Romans 6:4

The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full. John 10:10

• You can now <u>rest</u> in the finished work of the Savior.

Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Matthew 11:28

- You can face death with <u>confidence</u> rather than fear.
- You can live knowing there's always <u>forgiveness</u> for the past & <u>hope</u> for the future.
